

Application for Additional Troop Money-Earning

GIRLS SCOUTS TROOP MONEY-EARNING GUIDELINES

- Participation in the GSEM cookie sale is a prerequisite to troops participating in other troop money earning activities.
- Each girl's participation in troop money earning activities is voluntary.
- Their participation in the activity does not provide financial proceeds to other organizations.
- Their participation in fundraising campaigns is limited to appropriate support activities such as packaging or distribution of materials and making posters.
- Daisy Girl Scouts do not participate in money-earning activities beyond GSEM product sales.
- Each troop should determine the need for extra money before completing this application.
- Product demonstration types of money earning activities, parent fund raising on behalf of troops (except for Daisy Girl Scout troops/groups), raffles and drawings are not appropriate troop money earning activities.
- Troop money earning activities shall not occur during GSEM -sponsored product sales.
- Review Standards 28, 29, and 30 on pp 74-75 in *Safety Wise* and follow them when planning and implementing the money earning activity.
- Submit this application to the Regional Director/Director Community Collaboration for your community. A signed copy will be returned to the troop volunteer and the Service Unit Coordinator when it is approved. This form may be submitted electronically.
